Among them, many companies' safety management system obtained third-party certification. Companies put a lot of material and human resources for the establishment of the system, many companies hired professional consultancy to coach system setting up, the system finally get set up and certified. But after running the system for some time, the company began to find that the management system cannot effectively control the occurrence of the accidents, the system exists only for certification. Every time before the certification examination, the relevant personnel are always busy to modify files, make records.

Why the operation of safety management system encounters such a problem?
